BELOVED SCHOOLHOUSE RESTORATION

In the early 1890's, bachelor miner, Charlie Hintz, had done so well in mining that he had expanded his enterprises to operating a lumber mill at Doon near Magalia. Charlie recieved the contract to build the Centerville School and transported lumber down to the canyon by ox team for the construction and completion of the building in 1894. He sold the school to the district for \$600.00. In the first year, Ms. Ada Woods, moved in as school teacher and the two fell in love and were married in 1895. Lucky Charlie got \$600 and a school teacher out of the deal.

For over a 130 years our schoolhouse, born of

a love story, has weathered fire, rain, and blistering heat to first provide our canyon's youth with an education and now provide our community with a place to meet. Recently our board contracted with C. D. Jones Contracting and Don Hansler Painting to effect the extensive repairs due to weathering, dry rot, and peeling paint.

This last year, we spent over \$15,000 on removing and trimming trees that were an imminent danger to fall on the schoolhouse and museum. This year we are renovating the schoolhouse and we could use your help.


