

### CAMP FIRE COMMEMORATION EVENT

On Sunday, November 5th, CRHA hosted an anniversary event at the Centerville Schoolhouse and Museum. This event was supported by a grant from the Camp fire Collaborative.

Approximately 100 people attended; most of them Butte Creek Canyon residents. A few canyon residents spoke about the hardship and loss experienced, as well as about the new growth and resiliency evident in the years since the fire. A memorial plaque was unveiled, along with a beautiful handmade quilted banner of the canyon skillfully sewn by Linda Dickenson, and daffodils were handed out as a symbol of resiliency. A special permanent display of the Camp Fire's impact was designed by Huibert Venema from photos, letters and videos shared by community members. It is available to view any Saturday and Sunday from 1:00 to 4:00, and is a permanent part of our museum. # UPDATE ON COVERED BRIDGE REBUILD

As you may know, the Honey Run Covered Bridge Association has received sufficient funding from the Fire Victim Trust to complete (or nearly complete) the rebuild of the Honey Run Covered Bridge. These funds combine with the hundreds of generous donations from local citizens, businesses and foundations to bring us closer to our shared vision of rebuilding the iconic Covered Bridge.

Here is our current timeline. This spring (hopefully April), the shaped and treated lumber, as well as brackets and braces for Phase 2 (deck and trusses), will arrive at the Covered Bridge Park by trucks from Western Wood Structures of Tualitin, Oregon. These pieces will then be assembled by Q&D Construction of Sparks, Nevada, who completed Phase 1 in 2020. During July, the 3 large structures will be lifted into place atop the columns and abutments. Stay tuned for memorable photo/video opportunities! Phase 3 will be completed later in 2024 or in 2025. This will include siding and roof. Request for bids will be sent out soon only to Butte County contractors. The Covered Bridge Board of Directors are

the Covered Bridge Board of Directors are deeply appreciative for the patience and enduring support from residents of Butte Creek Canyon and beyond in this effort to restore the beloved, historic Covered Bridge.

Meanwhile, fundraising will continue to bring in the approximately \$50,000 required annually to maintain and improve the Covered Bridge Park. On the mornings of December 2 and 3 we again will hold our ornament sales at True Value Hardware, now located at 936 Mangrove, Chico. Hope to see you there.
